1. Minutes of previous meeting

2. Matters Arising

- a. Jubilee Walk regeneration: NR to contact Allan Munro for permission to commence works. NR to quote for groundworks to lay path.
 - b. Benches funded by Tesco Bags of Help: a total of 7 benches in rotation, 4 out at a time to allow for repairs & repainting. Locations decided as: Jubilee Walk, outside the Old Museum site, along cycle path. LC to obtain quotes for plaques for benches.
