Zoom meeting

1. **Present:** Moira Thomson(MT), Janet Kinnaird (JK), Liz Duncan (LD), Jon Bailey (JB), Cllr Pippa Hadley (PH).

3. **Declaration of interests:** Jon Bailey and Liz Duncan re ARC Kingussie.
4. **June minutes :** Proposed by JB seconded by LD.
5. **Matters Arising:**
 - Resilient Communities Fund application refused on the grounds that if we used the money as proposed (family picnic for KPS) the same would have to be done for all other schools. Following discussion it was agreed that KPS would be asked if they required funding for an activity and KVCC would support. **Action JK**
 - **PH** reported no further information re Tait's Brae Gynack Road. The consensus was to give this one last attempt by gauging the feeling of the residents. **Action JK**
